Rules and Regulations

1. Any visitor desiring to place a geocache/letterbox in a Bonita Springs Park is required to complete a Geocaching/Letterbox Placement Permit. There will be no fee for this permit at this time.
2. Permits are valid for one year from date approval. Upon expiration of the permit, the geocache or letterbox must be re-permitted to a new location, or removed.
3. Cache containers larger than 3 cubic inches must be made of clear non-breakable material; they must have a latch or other closing device to prohibit exposure to wildlife. All cache containers must be approved by site supervisor preceding placement.
4. The cache/letterbox shall not be buried and shall not be affixed to or disturb any vegetation, baseball or soccer field, or utility lines.
5. Park staff may check the cache/letterbox and the contents inside at anytime.
6. The cache/letterbox shall not contain any illegal, inappropriate, offensive, hazardous materials, or food items.
7. If at anytime during the permitted period, a park staff member determines the cache or its content to be unsafe for visitors or wildlife, or if it contains items listed in paragraph 6, the owner will be notified, and the cache removed. If the cache owner requests to relocate the cache, a new permit will be required.
8. If the park staff is unable to make contact with the cache owner, the cache will be considered abandoned property. The cache will be kept at the facility for 30 days after notice is sent to the email or address, at which time it is not claimed, it is to be disposed.

I have read and agree to abide by the Bonita Springs Parks & Recreation rules and regulations on geocaching and letterboxing. Bonita Springs Parks and Recreation reserves the right to remove any cache that is found to be in violation of this policy, this may result in enforcement action against me in accordance with Bonita Springs Parks & Recreation Ordinances.
